End-of-life care is never easy but having the right information, at the right time, can make an enormous difference.

If your loved one wishes to remain at home, there is an end-of-life support pathway designed for older people who are estimated to be in the last three months of life, with the option of a one-month extension where appropriate.

This pathway can provide up to \$25,000 in funding over a 12-week period, which may be used for personal care, nursing support, and essential equipment to support safe, comfortable care at home. This replaces any other funding you may have through My Aged Care.

Prestige end-of-life care at home includes:

- Comfort and continuity in familiar surroundings, supported by nurses and carers who take the time to know you.

There are multiple pathways to access care at home. Clinical care is commonly provided through GPs and specialist or state-based palliative care teams, with many services Medicare funded.

In-home support can also be accessed through My Aged Care, including Support at Home, or arranged privately where quicker or additional support is needed.

Eligibility and timing can vary. Early guidance can be helpful to ensure you understand the pathways, what support is available and when to access it.

You and your family are supported by a coordinated care team to help reduce uncertainty and provide reassurance during a deeply emotional time.
