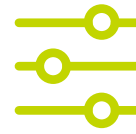

We help families understand the end-of-life process, care techniques, medication use, and facilitating final wishes.

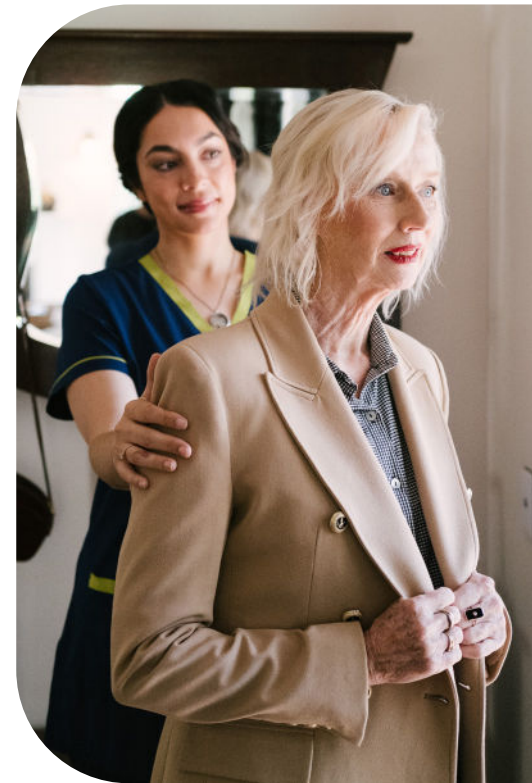
We continue to support families through funeral home liaison, removal of supplies and equipment, and the notification of relevant services.

You may be eligible for government funded care under the Support at Home program. The End-of-Life Pathway provides up to \$25,000 under Support at Home for older people with 3 months or less to live who wish to remain at home.
